Representation of the Meaning of Awe in the Lyrics of the Song "From Another Planet" by Sal Priadi (Semiotic Analysis of Ferdinand De Saussure)

ABSTRACT: Music or lyrics are an inseparable element in human life since ancient times until now, because song lyrics have a deep emotional impact on listeners who feel connected to the lyrics of the song. So that many songwriters express a feeling, anxiety, or social reality they see, through a song lyric. The Representation of the Meaning of Amazement in the lyrics of the song "From Another Planet" by Sal Priadi", aims to represent the meaning of amazement in the lyrics of the song using semiotic theory. The semiotic theory used to dig deeper into the lyrics of the song "From another planet" is Ferdinand De Saussure's semiotic theory, which aims to find out how the signifier and signified in the song lyrics. Songs like "From another planet" not only convey complex feelings but also have deep meaning. The results of this study suggest that the song "From another planet" describes a feeling that arises when one feels overwhelmed or admire, when the person's presence brings out unique, different from the previous one, or gives new color to the song writer's life.

INTRODUCTION

Music or songs are things that we often hear in everyday life, even from ancient times until now, humans humans cannot be separated from music or songs (Li & Chiu, 2018; Suwena et al., 2023). Because basically the song will make someone who listens to it become calmer, happy, sad, and even cry. Usually a song, has an implied meaning expressed by the songwriter for the listeners (Kim Lian & Binti Saikim, 2021; Rosa et al., 2022; Soica, 2016). Which is where the song is also a form of artwork in the form of a musical composition that expresses the thoughts and feelings of its creator through the elements of music, namely rhythm, melody, harmony, form, song structure and expression as a unit. (Nora et al., 2022). According to Moeliono in (Yudha Erlangga & Widi Utomo, 2021), in using song lyrics a poet must be good at processing words, so that the meaning of the message given can be conveyed properly (Chongwilaikasaem & Chalermyanont, 2023; Cookey et al., 2016; Kuecker & Hartley, 2020). Songs have many genres and meanings in the lyrics, one of which is the meaning of admiration.

Each song lyric contains various meanings that are poured out by the songwriter to describe a situation, with the aim of attracting listeners' attention (Gillan, 2017; Wei et al., 2017). Rahadian, (2020) explains that, generally, a lyric is composed with a simple structure and message, but there are also lyrics that vary in terms of complexity of structure and depth of message. As a result, music that is only an instrument, without lyrics, is difficult to fully enjoy, understand or feel. Therefore, song lyrics are meaningful words that come from a person's thoughts (Tjarve et al., 2017). Usually, song lyrics are a series of meaningful words that come from the thoughts of the writer or individual (Gunadi, 2023). In music, song lyrics are a person's personal expression of the experiences that the writer has gone through. To express these experiences, a songwriter uses wordplay and language to create interest and distinctiveness in a lyric. Language games include creative use of vocals, unique language styles and deviation of word meanings (Lee et al., 2017; Lewis et al., 2021; Ni et al., 2021). The use of melody and musical notation in harmony with the song lyrics further deepens the listener's experience, allowing them to feel what the songwriter is thinking and feeling (Chapae et al., 2020; Tang et al., 2022; Yumaev, 2023). Therefore, the use of language in song lyrics not only serves as a medium to express a feeling, but also becomes an important part that forms a deep experience for the listener and allows them to feel what the songwriter is thinking and feeling Gunadi, 2023).

Pradopo (Rahadian, 2020) argues that every song lyric has a distinctive language style. According to Awi (Rahadian, 2020), that the language or meaning of words that are reinforced by musical notation that is adjusted to the song lyrics, makes the listener more immersed in the meaning of the message in a song. The use of appropriate language has a great influence on the emotions and thoughts of readers or listeners, so the use of language is very important in creating a song that is captivating and meaningful (Puspita et al., 2023)

Through a lyric and the right use of language, a person will be able to understand, feel, and interpret a song. In simple terms, lyrics become a verbal communication, because of the delivery of messages through legu lyrics using words instead of symbols (Febrianty & Irawan, 2022). The meaning of the message in the song is important because it can have a positive influence on the listener. Because songs not only provide entertainment meaning, but can provide messages of motivation, comfort, even influence behavior, and can also have a positive impact on listeners (Putri, 2023)

Awe is a feeling that one feels when witnessing something extraordinary (Digun-Aweto et al., 2019; Lu et al., 2017; Pearce et al., 2017). Awe can also occur after attraction. According to the Kamus Besar Bahasahas Indonesia (KBBI), awe is a feeling of wonder with a sense of praise, amazement or astonishment. Generally, sources of awe come from music, art experiences, the supernatural, nature, and self-achievement (Kennett et al., 2022; Reichert et al., 2022). But not only that, the source of awe can come from other people (Keltner, 2024). The experience of awe can increase meaning in life. So to express the meaning of awe, it can be conveyed through a song lyric . Because through the song lyrics, listeners can feel the intensity of admiration and how it changes the way they see life (Fong et al., 2017; Redmore et al., 2023; I. Song, 2021).

The meaning of admiration is conveyed through a song sung by Sal Priadi entitled "Dari Planet Lain" which was released on March 8, 2024. The song contains a deep meaning of a feeling of awe (S. Song et al., 2021; W. Song, 2018, 2023). Through the lyrics, this song tries to convey a sense of admiration for someone who has been present in his life, so that the presence of this person gives new color and meaning to his life. The song "Dari Planet Lain" also became a boom, because many listeners turned out to be related to the situation they were experiencing, this is evidenced

by the use of the song as a backsound on Instagram which reached 215 thousand reel posts on Instagram reels, 771.6K posts on tiktok, and not only that, the music video for Dari Planet Lain has been watched 1.6 million times on Youtube, so this shows how broad the emotional impact of the song is on social media.

This phenomenon confirms that music has the power to unify and communicate emotions that may be difficult for someone to express in words. Thus, the song "Dari Planet Lain" not only serves as a medium that conveys personal feelings and experiences, but also a means to express emotions that are difficult to express verbally. Through the song "Dari Planet Lain", it creates a strong emotional bond between individuals and affects emotions deeply, proving that music can play an important

Therefore, this research is based on previous research that is used as a reference. Previous research was conducted by Dauhah Fitriyani Gunadi, 2023 entitled "Representation of the Meaning of Separation in the Lyrics of the Song "Give Me Five" by JKT48", with the findings that the song has a message about separation is not the end of everything. Then Pratiwi Siti Yulia Putri, 2023Pratiwi Siti Yulia Putri, 2023, entitled "Representation of Meanings and Messages in the Lyrics of the Song "A Dance That Never Finishes" by Nadin Amizah, with the results of research that found the meaning of the message of disappointment, and then the meaning of the message. Rahma Fatiya, Mufahanim Ananda Putri, Windi Kartika Wati, and Titik Sudiatmi (2024). The research results of the meaning of romanticism in the song lyrics tell about someone who is in love and is associated with a romantic relationship in the form of triangles that are interrelated with one another (Cánovas-Segura et al., 2023; Eiland & Rogers, 2022). The similarity with previous research is that it examines the meaning of a song lyric, and while the difference between this research and previous research is that it reveals the meaning of admiration for someone in the lyrics of the song "From another planet" by Sal Priadi. Therefore, this research is important to study because this research can make a significant scientific contribution in understanding the representation of the meaning of admiration in works of art, especially in song lyrics.

So to understand more deeply about the meaning of admiration from a song lyric, a relevant analysis method is needed. One of the appropriate methods is semiotics, which studies the details of meaning or signs (Adami et al., 2022; Alsaqer, 2019; Dolgopolovas & Dagiene, 2022). By using Ferdinand De Saussure's unit of analysis in (Wibawa & Natalia, 2021)which says that, semiotics is used to classify signs that can only represent something if the reader of the sign has experience of its representation. Saussure (in Febrianty & Irawan, 2022)Saussure (in Febrianty & Irawan, 2022) places a symbol in the context of human communication distinguishing between the elements of the signifier (signifier) and the signifier (signified), so that in the sign revealed sound image or a concept as two components that cannot be separated. In simple terms, the signifier is the physical element of the sign which can be a word, image or sound, in other words the signifier, is a meaningful sound, which is about what is said and what is written or read. While the signified, shows the absolute concept that approaches or becomes a mental image, namely the mind or concept of the mental aspect of language (Sobur Gunadi, 2023)

Admire is a feeling that one feels when witnessing something extraordinary. Admire can also occur after attraction. According to the Kamus Besar Bahasahas Indonesia (KBBI), admire is a feeling of wonder with a sense of praise, amazement or astonishment. Generally, sources of admire come from music, art experiences, the supernatural, nature, and self-achievement. But not only that, the source of admire can also come from other people

Like this, the song sung by Sal Priadi entitled "From another planet" is a song released on March 8, 2024. The song has a very deep meaning to someone who is present in his life. So that the song "From another planet" becomes a boom, because it is often used as a backsound by Tiktok and Instagram users, to show the presence of someone they love and admire. In addition, the messages in this song make the listeners relate to the situation they are experiencing (Xu & Song, 2023; Zhang & Song, 2019). This is evidenced by the use of songs as backsound on Instagram as many as 150 thousand posts on Instagram reels, 494.1k posts on TikTok, and not only that, the music video for From another planet has been watched 1.6 million times on Youtube.

Based on this phenomenon, it confirms that music has the power to unify and communicate emotions that may be difficult to express with ordinary words. Thus, the song "From another planet" is not only a medium that conveys feelings and experiences, but also a means to express emotions that are difficult to express verbally. Because songs have the ability to create emotional bonds between individuals and can deeply affect our emotions and brains (Ausmees et al., 2018; Sherpa & Song, 2023).

Based on the explanation above, this research uses a qualitative research method with a semiotic theory approach from Ferdinand De Saussure because this theory helps to analyze the representation of the meaning of awe in the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain" by Sal Priadi, through the concept of signifiers and signs defined by Ferdinand De Saussure. This research also aims to find out the meaning of awe from the song "Dari Planet Lain" sung by Sal Priadi, using the semiotic analysis of Ferdinand De Saussure, so that it can find out the signifier and signification of the song entitled "Dari Planet Lain".

METHOD

The method used in this research is a qualitative research method with a concstructivism paradigm. Qualitative research methods are data collected in the form of words, sentences, or images that have meaning and can lead to a more real understanding than just numbers or frequencies (Dr. Farida Nugrahani, 2014). In the constructivism paradigm, viewing reality is not formed scientifically, but is formed and constructed. In addition, this paradigm sees reality as a symbolic formation through social interaction (Butsi, 2019). The main purpose of qualitative research in the constructivism paradigm is to understand the phenomenon throught interpretation, not just to develop highly objective methods to approach reality (Jahja, 2018)

The approach used in this research is to use the semiotic theory of Ferdinand De Saussure, which is a science that studies signs. Ferdinand De Saussure said that semiotics is generally used as a tool to define the category of signs that can only present something if the reader of the sign has experience of its representation. According to Saussure too, a sign can be called a sign if there is a signifier and a signified. In this case, whatever is captured by our minds that is written or what is read is the signifier while the signified is the meaning or message that exists in our minds about something we capture. The theory of semiotics by Ferdinand De Saussre is used in this research, to interpret and understand the meaning of awe contained in the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain" by Sal Priadi. A sign, in Saussure's approach, is a concrete representation of a sound image and is often associated with a sound image as a signifier. In other words, the sign expresses the sound image or concept as two inseparable components (Gunadi, 2023). According to Ferdinand,

the sign cannot be conveyed without a signifier, because in the process of petsanda or signifier will produce external reality or signifier (Sitompul et al., 2021).

The data used in this research are primary and secondary data. Primary data is obtained from the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain" itself and secondary data is information obtained from other sources, such as books, the internet, literature studies relevant to this research, which researchers use to find out the meaning of awe in the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain". The steps taken in this research are using word analysis techniques by separating all song lyrics into several stanzas, then researchers will analyze using semiotic theory from Ferdinand De Saussure. In addition, researchers will also use listening techniques and listening techniques, researchers will listen to the song "From Another Planet" carefully and explore the meaning contained in each stanza to get a deeper understanding of the messages and symbolism in the song lyrics.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

The data analyzed in this study are data sourced from a collection of songs by Sal Priadi, namely "From another planet". Sal Priadi is a singer and songwriter. Sal Priadi's singing style combines ogf pop, folk, and indie. Sal Priadi is often known for his simple yet colorful musical style. Each of his songs is able to create an intimate and deep atmosphere, as if he is inviting the listener to enter into his own emotional journey. His lyrics also contain wisdom about everyday life. Sal Priadi's song describe personal experiences in a simple but meaningful way. So that the songs sung by him, often hit the hearts of listeners from various backgrounds.

One of them is the song "From another planet" with a duration of 02.49 minutes, which has been heard millions of times on Youtube, and hundreds of people have used the song as a backsound. The release of this song stole the attention of the public, especially for those who feel related to this song, and also with this song, can help them express what they feel about someone who is present in their lives and feel different or unique when that person is present. Here are the full song lyrics of the song "From another planet" by Sal Priadi

Analysis of the meaning of amazement in sng lyrics "From Another Planet"

The song analyzed is a song created by Sal Priadi with the title "From another planet". this research uses Ferdinand De Saussure's semiotic theory, where the sentences has a different meaning from the original lyrics. The following explanation is related to the meaning of admire in the lyrics of the song "From another planet":

The act of "Hand in Hand" symbolizes physical and emotional closeness, signifying intimacy, trust, and a strong connection between the singer and the person in question.

Overall Analysis:

This stanza explains that after everything that happened, experienced by the singer when the person was present in his life, the singer felt sure that the person was brought in specifically for people like the singer. By using the metaphor "From Another Planet", the singer implies that the person has a uniqueness that feels like not an ordinary person. The phrase "i'm sure" shows a belief or a trust experienced by the author towards that person.

CONCLUSION

Based on the results of the above research, it can be shown that the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain" have a deep meaning expressed through the analysis of Ferdinand De Saussure's Semiotics model. The results of the analysis show that the meaning of admiration contained in the lyrics of the song "Dari Planet Lain" by Sal Priadi, has a deep meaning about a feeling of admiration. The feeling of awe that the singer has towards the "person", because the presence of the "person" brings new colors to the singer's life as if the "person" comes from another planet, who comes to the world to accompany the singer, as evidenced by the lyrics "You Accompany Me Slowly, Side by Side Not in a Hurry" and is able to understand and provide new understanding in a different way, and also provides a meaning and tranquility. With the presence of this person who is unique and full of warmth and not in a hurry to force things, reinforcing a sense of calm to the songwriter, thus creating a deep sense of admiration In this case, the author highlights how the feeling of admiration can actually provide a sense of security, comfort, and provide a new understanding of love, which was previously shrouded in confusion or fear. This study also suggests further research. It is suggested to explore the meaning of awe contained in the video clip 'From Another Planet'. Observation of the artistic visualization in the video clip can provide a deeper understanding.
